## JUSTIFICATION

For 2012 Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), significant increases in appropriation were provided particularly in the following items:

1) Training Expenses - allocation for the Calendar 2012 was increased to P20,000,000.00 to be spent for training, seminar, workshop, attendance to local and international seminar and symposia including division, regional and national conferences and competitions that will advance quality education, to wit;

- 2) Schools & Office Supplies Expenses a large increase in the appropriation for school and office supplies were allotted from P1,000,000.00 to P15,277,873.00 to ensure teacher benefits for 2012. Provision of supplies such as chalk allowance, etc., could be the basis for additional teachers benefits;
- Medical, Dental & Laboratory Supplies Expenses this year allocation is P1,500,000.00 intended to provide medical and dental supplies to schools. This year, with the K+12 curriculum, Day Care Centers run by the Mayor's Office could benefit from this allocation by providing them with supplies taken from Special Education Fund (SEF) instead of the usual General Fund (GF) since these Day Care Centers will now be considered as part of DepEd K+12 program;
- Gasoline, Oil and Lubricants Expenses allocation of gasoline for 34 schools and DepEd Taguig City officials are taken from the GF despite appropriation from SEF. For this year, it was increased from P1,000,000.00 to P5,000,000.00 so that gas expenditures will no longer be taken from GF. For 2011, DepEd Taguig-Pateros (TAPAT) consumed around 1,500 liters of gasoline for school vehicle alone excluding gas allocations for buses used for DepEd activities;
- Textbook & Instructional Materials Expenses the amount appropriated (P50,000,000.00) was the combined amount appropriated for 2011 from the regular SEF and Supplemental SEF Budget. The allocation is intended for the following materials including pre-school workbooks and additional textbooks for MAPEH, TLE and Values Education subject areas which were not provided by DepEd. The Division of TAPAT presently has a ratio of one (1) book per five (5) students or 1:5 ratio in these subject areas:
  - a. Preschool Instructional Materials;

  - Cyber Education Content Production allocation was increased from P20,000,000.00 to P30,000,000.00 in order for Mayor Maria Laarni L. Cayetano to have a landmark project in Information Technology (IT) for the following selected schools in Taguig City;

- Janitorial Supplies in anticipation of the yearly Brigada Eskwela in which the Office of the City Mayor takes a big role in providing for the basic necessities in preparing the school for class opening, an increase of P500,000.00 was provided to have a wider range of janitorial supplies which will be used by the schools during and after the Brigada Eskwela activity;
- LSB Special Projects a significant increase of P25,000,000.00, from P90,000,000.00 to P115,000,000.00, was made in anticipation of the increase in student population in public schools brought about by the programs and projects of the City Mayor such as scholarship programs, Taguig Learners Certificate (TLC) Program, etc. Aside from the projected 3% in elementary, 5% in secondary, increase in enrolment in public schools, considerable number of transferees from private schools are expected to join the public schools for School Year 2012 to 2013.; and
- Others (School Furniture & Fixtures) an increase in the appropriation for furniture and fixtures was also provided from P2,000,000.00 to P3,000,000.00 in anticipation of requisitions submitted by School Principals to Mayor's Office. Usually, when the Mayor approved the request, funds are taken from GF, so in order to save and maximize the utilization of SEF this allocation was created.
- Water Expenses in order to maintain hygiene and sanitation in the school especially among pre-school and 7) grade school students, an amount of P2,000,000.00 was appropriated in the SEF budget. This is in line with the support of the Local Government to the K+12 Program of the Department of Education which started last school year 2011-2012 where we provided Modular Classroom in public elementary school to accommodate pre-schoolers which now have been a regular part of basic education curriculum;
- Electricity Expenses similar allocation was appropriated compared to last year's allocation in the SEF 8) budget with the primary aim of encouraging schools to conserve electricity and conduct energy conservation measures that will minimize energy consumption in the City;
- Telephone Expenses (Landline) an increase of P232,000.00 was made in anticipation of the increase in 9) schools and offices to be provided with telephone facility;
- 10) Internet Expenses - similar allocation was provided to sustain internet access of schools and offices;
- Repairs and Maint. School Buildings a significant increase of P9,000,000.00 from the usual allocation 11) of P1,000,000.00 was made due to a noticeable increase in requisitions for repair and maintenance of offices including classroom buildings. Proper coordination with the Facilities and Management Office, will maximize the use of this appropriation;
- Repairs and Maint. School Facilities & Equipment an increase in the appropriation for the maintenance 12) of facilities and equipment were made primarily to transfer fund source from GF to \$EF (previous year's expenditures for this item were charged to GF). From P1,000,000.00 it will be raised to P3,000,000.00. Coordination with FMO shall be done in order to carefully oversee its utilization;

- Repairs and Maint. wotor Vehicles due to non-approval of the vehicle purchase from SEF by the DBM, cost of maintenance for school vehicles are expected to increase due to their present conditions, hence appropriation was retained to cover maintenance of these vehicles which are being use for DepEd activities;
- 14) Other MOOE:
  - a. Others an increase of P17,993,845.00 was made to sustain last year's allocation and to accommodate new scholars under the TLC Program and other programs;
  - b. Journalism appropriation was increased from P2,000,000.00 to P3,000,000.00 in anticipation of City's program to develop school paper in the schools of Taguig City which aim to highlight Mayor Cayetano's achievements, programs and projects through the school paper to be disseminated to all students of Taguig four (4) times a year;
  - c. Medical and Dental Program the allocation was raised to P10,000,000.00 to deliver the medical programs of Mayor Cayetano to the teachers and students of the City such as:

- d. Promotion of Arts & Culture Program an increase of P2,000,000.00 was made to strengthen Mayor Cayetano's program for the arts particularly in the seven (7) areas of the CHART (Culture, History, Arts, Research of Taguig) Program as proposed by DepEd Tapat;
- e. Scouting with the active participation of the DepEd Tapat in scouting activities, allocation was increase from P2,000,000.00 to P3,000,000.00 to sustain all of its programs and develop discipline and leadership among the students in Taguig City through scouting; and
- f. Sports Development Program an increase in allocation form last year by P1,000,000.00 was made in anticipation of hosting of the Regional Palaro in December 2012.
- 15) Construction/Rehabilitation of School Buildings from the usual P60,000,000.00 allocation it will be increased to P65,000,000.00 in support of the Single Shift School Project of the local government for schools in Taguig City. Priority shall be given to school categorized as hot-colored schools and schools with space for new construction. Building of four-storey classroom will be encouraged to maximize space; and
- 16) Equipment in order to cope with the past changing technology even in education, similar allocation was appropriated to provide for the following needs of the school for the improvement of educational facilities:
